Fire Captain / Paramedic

The Clearcreek Fire District is a progressive and growing fire protection district located between Dayton and Cincinnati in Southwest Ohio. The District is accepting applications for an eligibility list for the position of Fire Captain. This position will work a 40 hour or 24 / 48 schedule (53 hour work week) as assigned. This position may head a Division: Prevention and Planning, Training, EMS or 24 hour shift as the Shift Commander and will be assigned by the Fire Chief.

The Clearcreek Fire District is looking to establish an eligibility list for an individual who has a positive attitude, is a sincere team player, possesses strong leadership qualities, effective communication and interpersonal skills and who can accept and handle significant levels of responsibilities. Experience in leadership, public relations, planning, organizing, standards and current Fire/EMS service knowledge of procedures are a must.

All applicants are subject to the selection process. To be considered the , applicant shall have a valid Ohio driver's license; be a career Fire Lieutenant having seven (7) years of career fire experience, including not less than two (2) years progressive supervisory experience. A Bachelor's Degree in Public Administration, Fire or EMS Science or related fields is preferred. Applicant is required to have Ohio Paramedic, Level II Firefighter and Fire Safety Inspector Certification, and NIMS 100, 200, 300, 400, 700 and 800. Fire Officer I and II are required, Fire Officer III is desired. Specialized training such as Fire and /or EMS Instructor, the ability to operate under the Greater Miami Valley EMS Protocol as a Paramedic and qualification to operate all CCFD apparatus must be obtained within one year (365 days) of appointment. PALs, ACLS, CPR Instructor are also preferred. Requirements may be waived or equivalents accepted at the sole discretion of the Fire Chief. Starting salary is \$65,836.43 a year plus excellent benefits. Applicants will be required to complete Ohio Fire Executive (OFE) or Executive Fire Officer (EFO) and Fire Officer III.

Successful candidates may be subject to written testing, oral interview(s), assessment center, psychological evaluation, polygraph examination, in conjunction with an extensive personal history evaluation and medical examination to include drug testing. Several cuts may occur during the process, you will be advised if you are continuing in each step. Each step (date) will be announced as we progress.

Written Testing will be conducted on May 21, 2012 at 09:00 hours. Content tested will include Fire Officer I and II (content from NFPA 1021: Standard for Fire Officer Professional Qualifications). A physical agility test will immediately follow. The location for all testing to be announced to those selected to participate.
