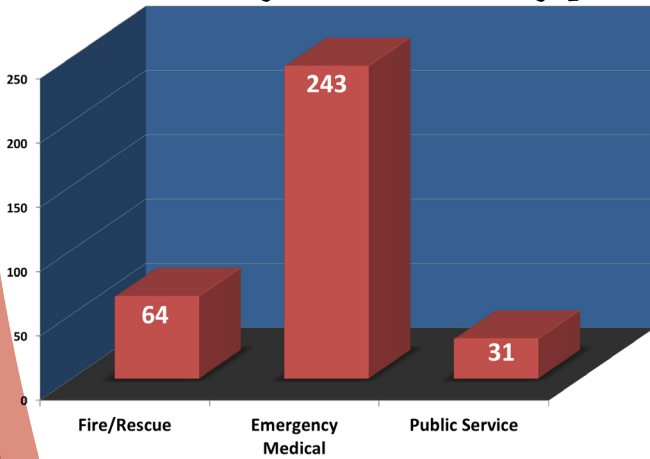




## Total Alarms

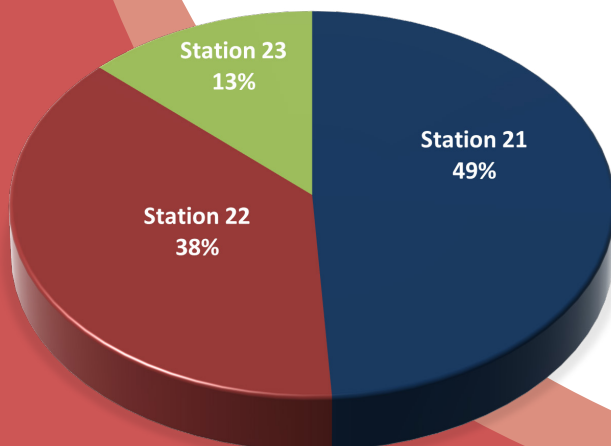
## Alarms by Service Type

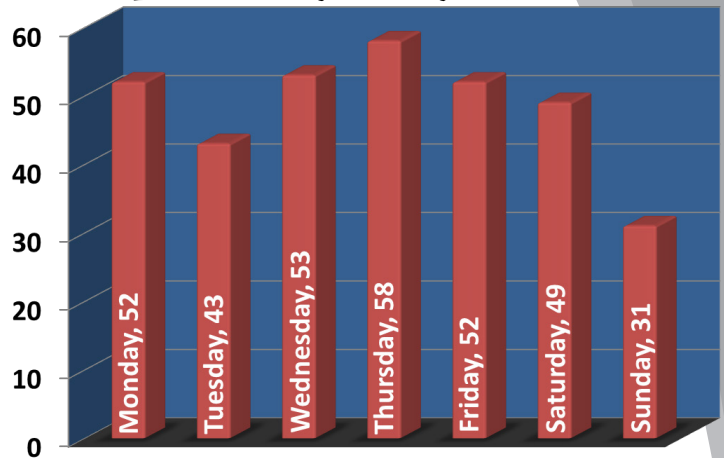
## Response Percentages

# SIGNIFICANT RESPONSES

On 1/2/23 @ 04:25 hours, crews responded to a residence for a reported pregnancy/childbirth. Upon arrival, crews found a patient in labor. During transport to the hospital, the patient went into delivery. Crews assisted in the birth and transported the patient and newborn to Kettering Health Washington Township.

On 1/8/23 @ 18:56 hours, crews responded to a nursing home for a reported cardiac arrest. Upon arrival, crews found a patient in cardiac arrest, with facility staff performing CPR. Crews initiated ALS procedures with no response from the patient. Medical Control provided a field termination of resuscitation efforts order. Crews contacted the coroner and released the scene to Springboro PD.

On 1/14/23 @ 18:53 hours, crews responded to a residence for a reported cardiac arrest. Upon arrival, crews found a patient in cardiac arrest. Crews initiated ALS procedures and transported the patient to Atrium Medical Center.



On 1/12/23 @ 11:31 hours, crews responded to State Route 73 for a reported motor vehicle accident with injuries. Upon arrival, crews found a truck off the roadway, on its side, with one person entrapped. Crews stabilized the vehicle and extricated the driver, who refused care and transport. After securing the site of hazards, crews released the scene to Clearcreek PD.



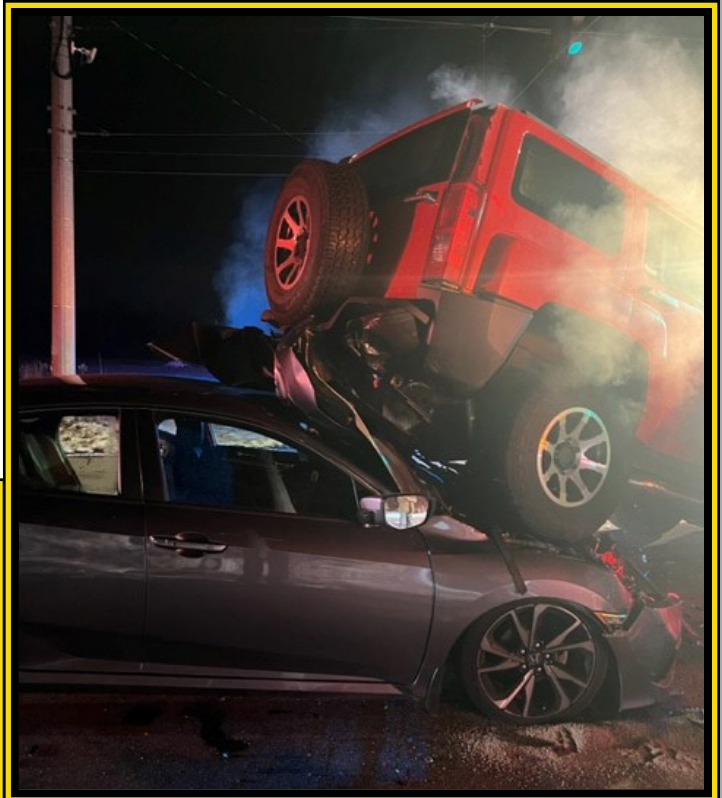
On 1/17/23 @ 22:00 hours, crews responded to Yankee Road for a reported motor vehicle accident with injuries. Upon arrival, crews found a single vehicle on its side down an embankment with two people entrapped. Crews stabilized the vehicle and removed trees to gain access for extrication. Crews transported one patient to Kettering Health Main Campus. Crews secured the site of hazards and released the scene to Springboro PD. Washington Township provided mutual aid assistance.



On 1/18/23 @ 14:31 hours, crews responded to Dayton Children's South Campus for a reported fire alarm. Upon arrival, crews found nothing showing, but Building Security advised of a smoke smell coming from a room in the Emergency Department. Crews laid a yard line while investigating the room for heat signatures but found no hazards. Building Maintenance Staff advised of a large amount of steam in the roof air handler duct, which triggered the fire alarm. Finding no hazards, crews returned to service. Miami Township and Washington Township provided mutual aid assistance.

On 1/18/23 @ 17:27 hours, crews responded to a residence for a reported cardiac arrest. Upon arrival, crews determined the patient was DOA. Crews contacted the coroner and released the scene to Clearcreek PD.

On 1/24/23 @ 19:55 hours, crews responded to State Route 48 and East Lytle Five Points Road for a reported vehicle accident with injuries. Upon arrival, crews found three vehicles involved in a crash with all occupants evacuated. Crews stabilized the vehicles and mitigated road hazards. Medic crews treated minor injuries on one patient, who refused transport. Finding no further hazards, crews released the scene to Clearcreek PD.



On 1/29/23 @ 12:58 hours, crews responded to State Route 48 for a reported vehicle accident with injuries. Upon arrival, crews found a single vehicle into a ditch with one occupant in the driver's seat. Once outside the vehicle, the driver denied injury. Finding the truck stable with no additional hazards, crews released the scene to Clearcreek PD.


