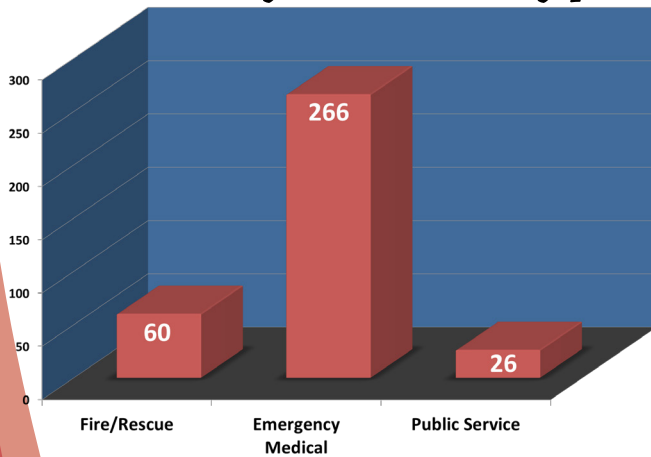

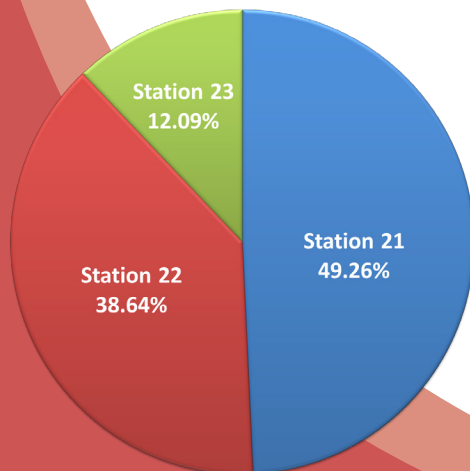
## Alarms by Service Type

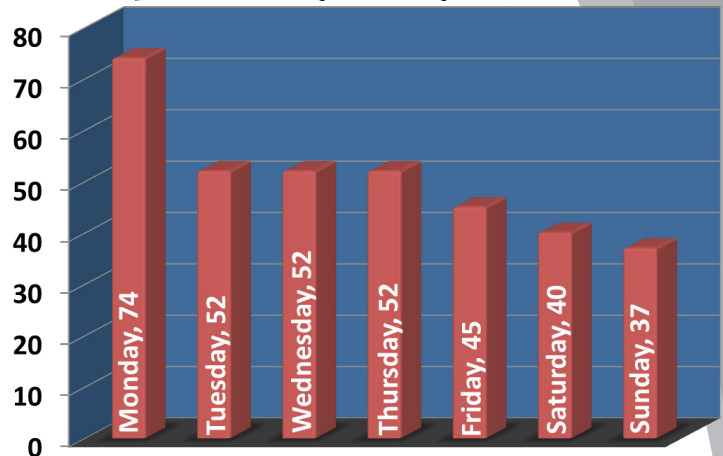
## Response Percentages

# SIGNIFICANT RESPONSES

On 11/3/21 @ 02:37 hours, Crews responded to a residence for a reported unconscious/unresponsive person. Upon arrival, crews found a patient unresponsive. Crews initiated ALS procedures and transported the patient to Sycamore Medical Center.

On 11/7/21 @ 05:03 hours, Crews responded to a nursing care facility for a reported non-breather. Upon arrival, crews found a patient DOA. Crews contacted the coroner and released the scene to Springboro PD.

On 11/8/21 @ 21:29 hours, Crews responded to a residence for a reported non-breather. Upon arrival, crews found a patient DOA. Crews contacted the coroner and released the scene to Clearcreek PD.

On 11/9/21 @ 04:14 hours, Crews responded to a residence for a reported non-breather. Upon arrival, crews found a patient unresponsive with Clearcreek PD performing CPR. Crews initiated ALS procedures but ceased care upon the presentation of a valid Do Not Resuscitate order. Crews released the scene to Clearcreek PD and returned to service.

On 11/11/21 @ 08:57 hours, Crews responded to a residence for a reported non-breather. Upon arrival, crews found a patient DOA. Crews contacted the coroner and released the scene to Springboro PD.

On 11/11/21 @ 08:54 hours, Crews responded to Central Park Court for a reported vehicle accident with injuries. Upon arrival, crews found a vehicle crashed into a building and leaking fluids. All occupants evacuated the vehicle and reported no injuries. Upon investigation, crews found the vehicle stable but leaking brake fluid. The impact compromised the structural integrity of the building's front porch and damaged drywall in the interior. Springboro PD requested a tow truck to remove the vehicle while crews built a t-shore to stabilize the porch. Crews contacted the Warren County Building Inspector and released the scene to Springboro PD.



On 11/11/21 @ 10:28 hours, Station 23 crews responded to a walk-in request for a reported overdose. Upon investigation, crews found a patient unresponsive but breathing in a car parked in the station lot. Crews initiated ALS procedures and transported the patient to Atrium Medical Center.

On 11/13/21 @ 12:30 hours, Crews responded to a residence for a reported non-breather. Upon arrival, crews found a patient in cardiac arrest. Crews initiated ALS procedures and transported the patient to Southview Medical Center.

On 11/20/21 @ 14:58 hours, Crews responded to a residence for a reported overdose. Upon arrival, crews found a patient unresponsive. Crews initiated ALS procedures and transported the patient to Franklin Emergency Care.

On 11/23/21 @ 11:39 hours, Crews responded to a mutual aid assistance in Turtlecreek Township for a reported unconscious/unresponsive person. Upon arrival, crews found a patient DOA. Crews contacted the coroner and released the scene to the Warren County Sheriff's Office.

On 11/23/21 @ 17:20 hours, Crews responded to a residence for reported breathing problems. Upon arrival, crews found a patient in respiratory failure. The Patient had a valid Do Not Resuscitate Order. Crews initiated BLS procedures and transported the patient to Kettering Medical Center.

On 11/24/21 @ 15:23 hours, Crews responded to a residence for a reported unknown illness. Upon arrival, crews found a patient hypotensive and initiated ALS procedures. The patient went into cardiac arrest during transport. Crews continued ALS procedures and transported the patient to Atrium Medical Center.

On 11/25/21 @ 19:41 hours, Crews responded to a residence for a reported non-breather. Upon arrival, crews found a patient unresponsive. Crews initiated ALS procedures and transported the patient to Atrium Medical Center.

On 11/27/21 @ 00:17 hours, Crews responded to the Enclave of Springboro for a reported appliance fire. Dispatch upgraded the call to a structure fire. Upon arrival, crews found a dishwasher producing light smoke. Crews disabled the main power switch for the dishwasher, which stopped the smoke. Crews checked for extension and, finding no further hazards, tagged the appliance out of service. No staff or residents reported injury. The estimated property loss due to fire is \$10,000.

On 11/29/21 @ 13:12 hours, Crews responded to a nursing home for a reported motor vehicle/pedestrian accident. Upon arrival, crews found a patient lying on the pavement after a car struck the patient's wheelchair. The patient showed bruising due to the fall. Crews initiated BLS procedures and transported the patient to Atrium Medical Center.
