During Safety Town week your child has received instructions on various topics and practices, to include; officer friendly, pedestrian safety, gun safety, road safety, bike safety, seatbelt safety, stranger safety, fire safety, bus safety, and internet safety.

The following is a list of questions you can review with your child:

A person who walks is a?

Pedestrian

Does a pedestrian walk against or with traffic?

Against

Do bikes ride against or with traffic?

With

What do we wear when riding a bike?

Helmet

Do cars stop at crosswalks?

If there is no crosswalk, where is the next safest place to cross?

Corner

What do we need to watch for before crossing on a cross walk?

Cars

What side of the road do cars drive on?

Right side

Who do you check with before you cross the street?

Mom, dad, or person in charge of you

How many ways and which ways do we look before crossing the street?

4 ways & left, right, left, shoulder

Do we walk or run when crossing the street?

We always walk

There are 3 colors on a traffic light:

What does red mean?

Stop

What does yellow mean?

Slow down, get ready to stop

What does green mean?

Go

If you see a gun, what should you do?

Stop, don't touch, run away, tell a grown up

What part of your body goes into the seat of a car?

Bottom

What is the phone number if there is an emergency?

911

Is a car crash or losing your dog an emergency?

Car crash

What is the first thing you do after getting your bottom in the seat (3 UP's)?

Buckle up

Then what do you do?

Lock up

What is the last UP to do?

Button up

Are you allowed to hang your head, hands, or arms out of the window of the car?

If someone throws something out of the window of the car and it lands on the ground, what is that called?

Littering

What information do you give the dispatcher after dialing 911?

What is the emergency, your name, phone number, and address

What is a stranger?

Danger Zone
