

Safety Town Safety Plan

- Please check your child's temperature each day before attending Safety Town. Any child or volunteer with a temperature above 100.2 should not participate.
- Please bring a mask for your child. Additional disposable masks will be available for participants who forget their mask.
- All children and volunteers will be required to wear masks upon entering the building and for the duration of their class.
- Check in will be outside on the west side of the building at door 3 (there will be a Safety Town banner and police cruisers parked by the entrance). Only Safety Town participants will enter the building, parents will remain outside.
- Children will arrive no more than 15 minutes prior to the start of class to sign in so officers can begin class PROMPTLY at 9 am and 1 pm

During Class

- Upon entering the building, hand sanitizer will be offered to children
- Each group will consist of a maximum of 10 children, with three groups for each session
- Cars and any other equipment used by each group will be disinfected between groups
- Bleachers will be sanitized between each group of students
- Students will exit through the west side building at door 3 (same as entry).
- Please arrive promptly to pick your child up at the end of each session.
- Hand sanitizer will be offered before snack time
- Small disposable water bottles will be provided, as needed, due to the closure of water fountains
- On graduation day, parents will be required to wear masks when entering the building, will maintain social distance, and will also be offered hand sanitizer

Please note that the above requirements are subject to change based on state and federal requirements and/or suggestions. Any changes to this Safety Plan will be shared with participants before classes begin in June.
