Monthly Report

March 2023

Taking advantage of warmer weather, Road Crews installed additional parking for Clearcreek Fire District Station 23, adding 25' x 55' to the existing lot.

Road Maintenance Inspections began in March. This process assists in prioritizing repair needs throughout the summer. A two-person team inspects all curbs in the township. Additionally, the team notes needed repairs for catch basins, roadway milling, and culvert pipes that need replacing before paving.





Late-month storms damaged the landmark Sycamore tree at Diane's Sycamore Reserve, causing a large branch to fall into power lines. Limb removal revealed rotted wood throughout the trunk, posing a safety hazard. Road Crews worked with the Warren County Engineers' Office to remove the tree. Clearcreek Township Road Maintenance provided the chipper. The Engineers' Office provided the grapple truck, large dump trailers, and a boom truck for tree trimming.

Crews also replaced an 18" culvert on Turner Drive, totaling 60' long.
