On March 18, 2025, Officers Hall and McWhorter responded to the Warren County Alternative school for a report of an unruly Juvenile. Upon investigation, a female juvenile was charged with disorderly conduct.

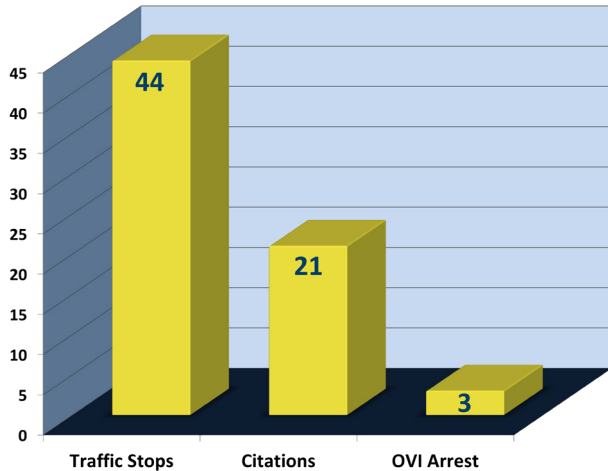
On March 15, 2025, Officers D. Williams and Schrage, responded to the intersection of East State Route 73 and Bunnell Hill Road, for a report of a vehicle stopped in the roadway with a driver possibly sleeping. While officers were attempting to contact the male driver, the driver was startled and took his foot off the brake and backed into one of the police cruisers. Upon investigation, the driver was arrested for O.V.I. and provided a breath test with a result of .13.

On March 14, 2025, Officer Schrage observed a suspicious vehicle in the 7500 block of Bunnell Hill Road. The male was observed parking his vehicle and getting out of the driver's side. Officers made contact with the male who stated he had pulled over to urinate. While officers were speaking with the male, they observed an odor of an alcohol and glassy eyes. Upon investigation, the male was charged with OVI.

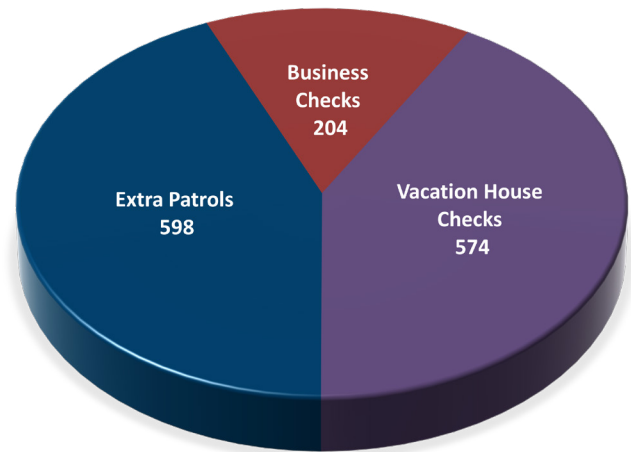
On March 13, 2025, Sgt. Sweet, Cpl. Knobbe, and Officer Horwarth, responded to a residence in the 9000 Block of Somerset Court for a trespassing complaint. A male was located and was initially given a warning for the trespassing violation and was allowed to leave the scene. Officers were later called back to the same location for the same male trespassing. The male was again located and charged with Criminal Trespass.

On March 13, 2025, Officer Bronnenberg was east bound on East State Route 73, near the intersection of North State Route 48, when he observed a vehicle in front of him cross over the white and yellow traffic lines numerous times. Upon investigation, the male motorist was charged with a Marked Lanes violation and OVI.

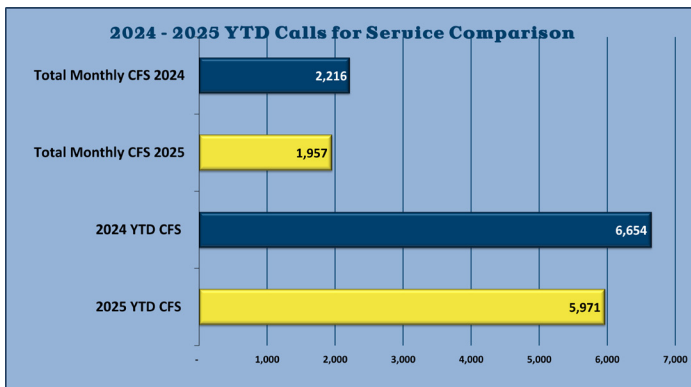

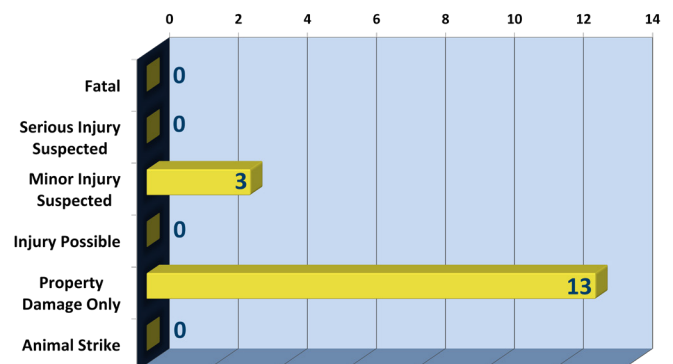

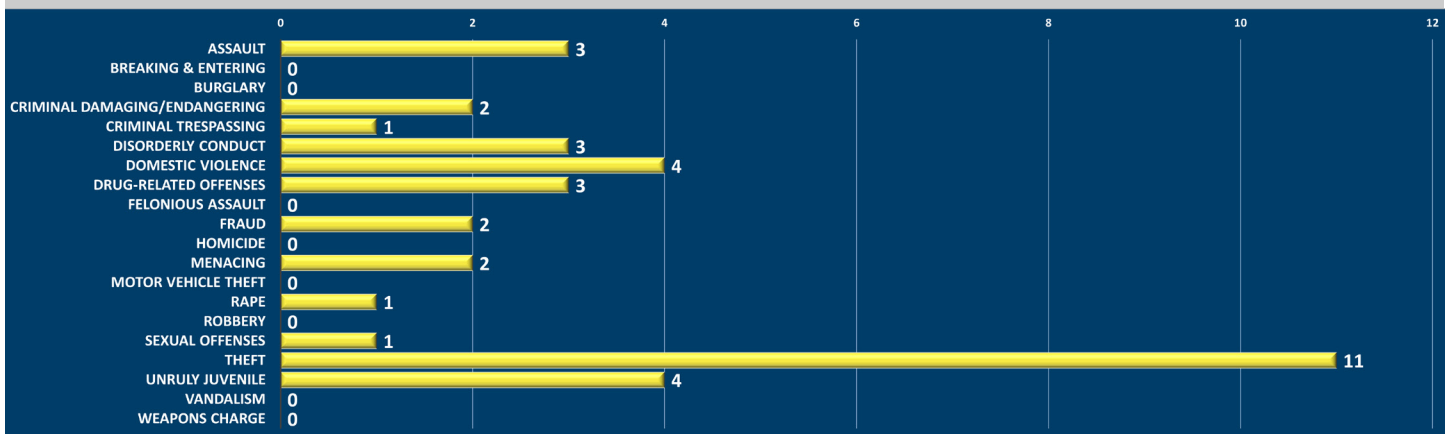
Calls for Service 2024 - 2025 YTD Comparison
