Monthly Report

June 2025

In June, crews continued applying mastic patching in South Stone Ridge and Horizon Hill for cape sealing scheduled for August. Mastic is used to level transverse cracks in the roadway. Crews have used a total of 47,250 lbs. of mastic this year.

On June 15th, a motor vehicle accident involving a semi caused damage to Bunnell Hill Road. Crews temporarily blocked the road while making repairs.



Heavy rains and flooding in June washed out soil on Weidner Road, creating a drop-off of several feet. Crews replaced the soil and graded the ditch. Additionally, crews used two loads of rip rap to repair the washed-out ditch at Crown Pointe and Bunnell Hill Road.



During the first week of June, crews graded the rear side of the gravel bins at Patricia Allyn Park to create space for storing the millings from roadwork in Stone Ridge. The millings will be used under guardrails throughout the township.

As weather permitted, crews installed two driveway pipes and dug one ditch in June.



The new Dodge 4500 service truck arrived and was outfitted with a Kanphade service bed. This truck will carry all standard tools used on most job sites, allowing crews to access the tools while towing the Bobcat. This truck replaces a 2006 Ford F-250 pickup truck.
