Significant Activity


On August 11, 2025, Sergeant Sweet was on patrol in the area of North State Route 48 and East State Route 73, when he observed a vehicle traveling in front of him commit numerous marked lanes violations. Officers performed a traffic stop with the vehicle and made contact with the male motorist. During contact with the motorist, officers detected the odor of an alcoholic beverage and red, watery eyes. The motorist performed field sobriety tests, and upon further investigation, was arrested for OVI with alcohol greater than .17 Grams in Breath and Operating a Motor Vehicle without a Valid License.

On August 8, 2025, Officer Robinson responded to a residence in the 700 block of Grand Wood Court in reference to a violation of a protection order complaint. A female at the residence, who had a protection order against a male, stated the male had sent her a text message to her cell phone, violating the protection order. Later that day the male suspect turned himself into Clearcreek Township police officers at the Police Station. He was charged with one count of Violation of a Protection Order.


On August 8, 2025, Corporal Knobbe and Sergeant Sweet responded to a residence on North Wood Creek Drive for a welfare check on a male. Initially, officers were not able to make contact with the male but found him parked in his vehicle later that same day. Upon making contact with the male, officers could smell the odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from the vehicle and the male. Upon further investigation, the male was charged with OVI with a BAC level greater than .17 Grams in Breath.




