Monthly Report

October 2025

In October, crews received notice of a blocked culvert pipe on Jade Point Court. Crews inspected the site and found that the pipe outlet was three feet below the ditch profile and that all utility lines were above the pipe, requiring the installation of a new pipe in a different location. To maintain adequate water flow, crews installed a larger 18-inch-diameter, 100-foot-long pipe.









Crews reserved Thursdays and Fridays in October to continue work on Weisenberger Road. This work included repairing damage caused by the creek, which encroached on the road in multiple areas. Crews repaired the damage using 46 loads of dirt and riprap to stabilize the areas. This project took nine days and completed a road improvement project planned for 2025. Additionally, crews scheduled a tree trimming company to clear limbs along the roadway, taking advantage of the road closure to minimize traffic delays, prolong the life of the asphalt by reducing snow and ice accumulation, and improve roadway safety.







Throughout the month, crews repaired the transverse cracks in Spring Meadows. The repairs required 12 skids of Mastic Patch, each weighing 2,250 pounds, which the crews applied by hand.

Lastly, Road Maintenance Crews repaired the berm on West Pekin Road, between State Route 741 and Springboro Road.
