Monthly Report

December 2025

In December, Road Maintenance crews responded to snowstorms and freezing temperatures, causing hazardous driving conditions. During these events, crews worked around the clock to clear the roadways and apply salt.

As the crews prepare for 2026, here is a recap of 2025:

Projects

Beginning in March, crews backfilled around the salt bin to deflect water from the building. This project continued into April by installing sod with assistance from the Park Department. It concluded in May by adding an extra gravel parking lot behind the salt bin for storage.



Road Crews added 234 tons of gravel to the Park Maintenance driveway leading to the Hoffmann Reserve in April.

The crews mastic patched South Stone Ridge, Spring Meadows, Station House, and Horizon Hill subdivisions, using 30 skids of mastic, to prepare for cape sealing.

The Road Department replaced 12 road culvert pipes in the township in 2025.

Throughout the year, crews ditched 21 roadside ditches for residents in the township.

Crews replaced four driveway pipes for residents.

After heavy rain in June, which resulted in five inches of accumulation, crews repaired a washout on Bunnell Hill Road at Binkley Lane by installing 72 tons of riprap.



In July, crews ditched the area in the 5200 block of Hathaway Road. Crews moved the ditch by three feet to allow for the addition of a culvert pipe extension. After installation, crews paved the road over the pipe.

Materials

- Purchased 2,000 tons of salt for the new salt bin.
- Purchased 143 tons of asphalt for road repairs.
- Purchased 1,632 tons of gravel.
- Purchased 67,500 lbs. of mastic.

Inspections

- Inspected and mapped 4,144 ft of guardrail.
- Inspected 1,957 roadway signs multiple times throughout the year.
- Inspected and graded 1,189 catch basins.
- Inventoried and graded 118 road culvert pipes.
- Evaluated all roads for Road Service Life for repaving.

Major Road Improvements

Crews repaired the berms on Weidner Road from Lower Springboro Road to Dearth Road, fixing all significant drop-offs along the pavement. Using dirt from the Police, Fire, and Road departments' building projects, crews repaired over 3,500 ft of road ditch, using 296 tons of dirt and 48 tons of riprap.

Crews removed 785 feet of fence and trees along the curve in the 4000 block of Weisenberger Road for better sight distance and made needed repairs to the ditch. Additionally, crews repaired three areas where the creek eroded soil within several feet of the pavement. This project required 300 tons of dirt and 68 tons of riprap for repairs.

Contracted Jobs

Barrett Paving paved 2.13 miles of road in South Stone Ridge and Quarter Horse Lane.

Strawser Construction Cape Sealed 2.77 miles of road in South Stone Ridge.

Barrett Paving repaired berms on West Pekin Road between State Route 741 and Springboro Road.

Strawser Construction crack-sealed 10.28 miles in the Winding Creek subdivision.

Ace Tree Service trimmed on Bunnell Hill Road, Weisenberger Road, and the intersection of Riley-Wills Road and Hathaway Road.

Aero-Mark Company striped 6.39 miles on North Bunnell Hill, Weidner, Weisenberger, and Harlin roads.

D.D.S. Street Sweeping swept 25 miles of curbed subdivisions this fall.
