On the Call

Significant Activity

On July 31, 2026, Officer McIntosh was on patrol in the area of Bunnell Hill Road and North State Route 48 when he observed a motorist failing to stop for the stop sign at the intersection. Officers conducted a traffic stop of the vehicle and observed the male motorist to have slurred speech and was confused about his location. There was also a juvenile passenger in the vehicle. Upon further investigation, the male motorist was charged with OVI and Endangering Children.

On July 19, 2026, Officers McIntosh and Bronnenberg responded to a residence in the 1400 block of Hemmingway Drive for a report of a Domestic Dispute. Upon arrival to the scene, officers contacted a male and female that had been involved in an argument. Upon further investigation, the female was charged with Domestic Violence.

On July 15, 2026, Officer Bronnenberg and Sergeant Sweet responded to the 9100 block of North State Route 48 for a report of a motorist slumped over the wheel of a stopped motor vehicle. Upon arrival, officers met with Clearcreek Township Medics who were already speaking to the male in the vehicle. Officers noticed the strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from the male, glassy eyes, and slurred speech. Upon further investigation, the male was charged with OVI.

On July 7, 2026, Officer Bronnenberg was on patrol in 2000 block of East State Route 73 when he observed a motorist that he had previously written a citation for driving under suspension. Officers conducted a traffic stop, and it was found that the male motorist was still under an active suspension. The motorist was charged with Driving Under Suspension.

On July 2, 2026, Officers Bronnenberg and Schrage responded to a residence in the 5800 block of Hathaway Road for a report of a Domestic Dispute. Upon arrival, officers were informed that a juvenile at the residence had attempted to hit another resident with a box cutter. Upon investigation, a juvenile was charged with Domestic Violence.





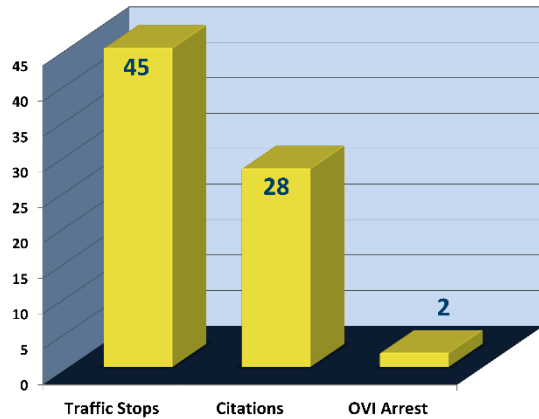
Engaging Our Community

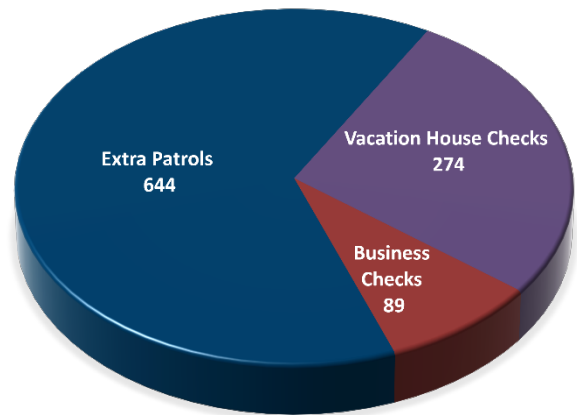

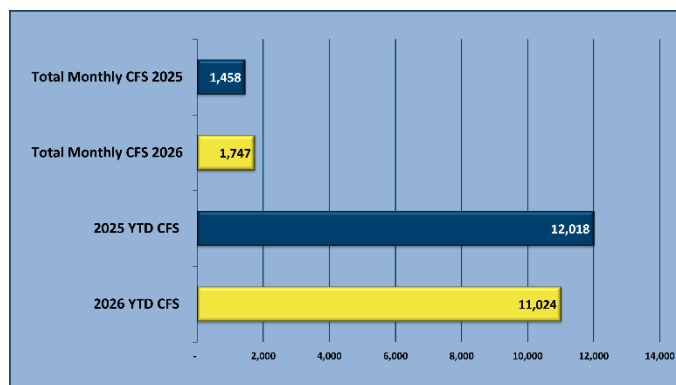

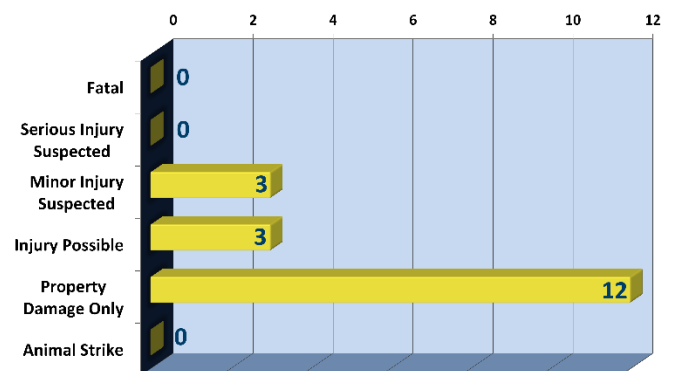
