On the Call

Significant Activity

On August 2, 2026, Officer Bronnenberg responded to the area of the 7000 block of Township Line Road for a report of a traffic crash. Upon arrival, officers found a vehicle that had driven into a driveway, through a yard, over a creek, and struck a tree. Officers made contact with the male driver and noticed slurred speech and glassy eyes. Alcoholic beverages were also found at the scene of the crash. The male was transported to the hospital by Clearcreek Township EMS for treatment. Upon investigation, the male was charged with OVI.

On August 3, 2026, while on patrol of the area of East St Rt 73, Officer Bronnenberg was notified of a vehicle in the area in which the motorist had an arrest warrant out of the City of Wilmington. Officers observed the vehicle traveling westbound on East St Rt 73 and stopped the motorist. The motorist was taken into custody for the arrest warrant and custody was turned over to the Wilmington Police Department.

On August 5, 2026, officers were advised by Warren County Dispatch of a vehicle that had driven through a fence on Kendrick Road, in Wayne Township, and had left the scene. Sgt. Sweet responded to the area of Lytle Five Points Road and located the suspect vehicle in the 9500 block of Whispering Stream Court. The vehicle was in the middle of the roadway with heavy front-end damage. A male was located near the vehicle, sitting in the grass, and was contacted by officers. With the help of neighborhood bystanders, officers were able to determine the male was the operator of the vehicle. Officers observed a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from the male and found empty alcoholic beverages in his vehicle. The male was transported to the hospital by Clearcreek Township EMS and was charged with OVI and Operating without being in Reasonable Control.

On August 6, 2025, Corporal D. Williams and Sergeant Sweet responded to a residence in the 1900 block of Legendary Way for a report of Domestic Violence. Upon arrival at the scene, officers spoke to the male and female residents who stated they had been in an argument over money. Upon investigation, it was found that the dispute had become physical, and after some investigation, the male was charged with Domestic Violence.

On August 14, 2026, Officer Robinson was dispatched to a report of a suspicious male in the area of North State Route 48 and Grand Cypress Blvd. Upon arrival, officers made contact with the male, and it was found the male had a warrant for his arrest out of Hamilton County. The male was taken into custody and turned over to the custody of the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office.

On August 30, 2026, Sergeant Sweet and Corporal Hall were dispatched to a residence in the 2700 block of East State Route 73 for a report of an Unruly Juvenile. Upon arrival, it was found that there had been an argument between two juveniles at the residence. An adult in the residence intervened in the argument between the two juveniles, and one of the juveniles became physical with the adult. Upon investigation, the juvenile was charged with Disorderly Conduct.

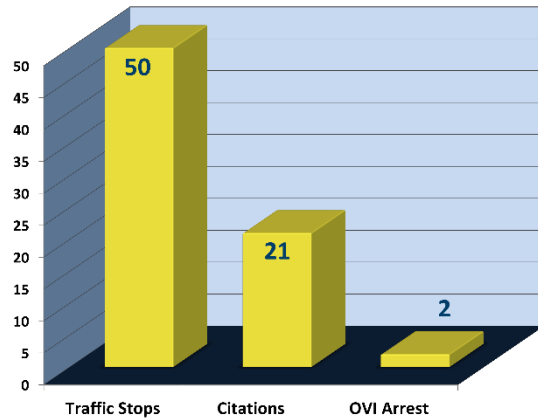

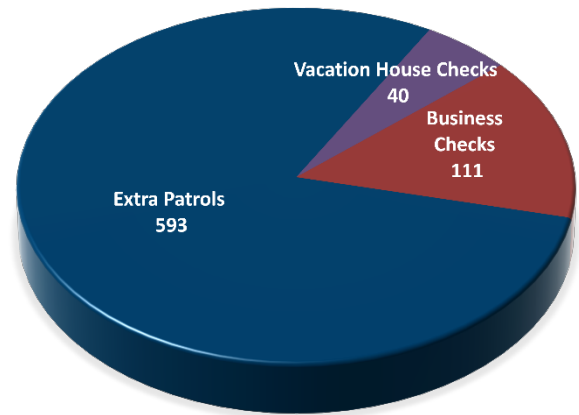

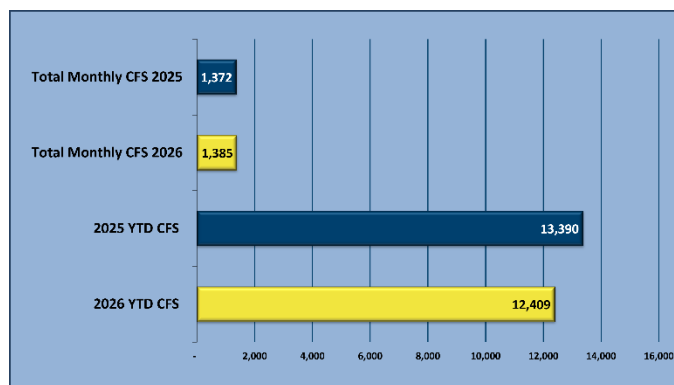

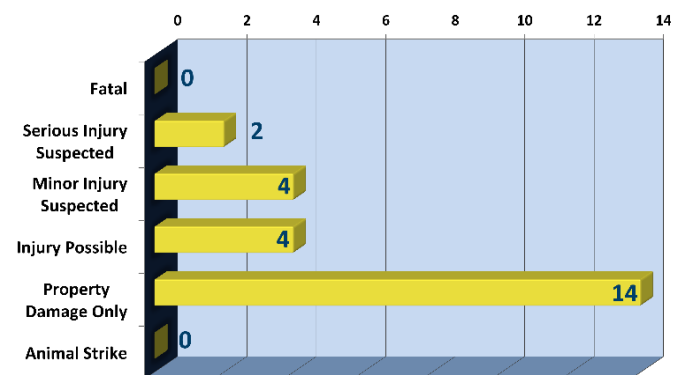
