## Excellence Through Training

All officers successfully completed Compliance and Control Tactics and Legal Updates training through OPOTA.

Additionally, officers attended an in-house defensive tactics training to maintain and enhance operational readiness.

Additionally, Corporal Daron Williams completed the Supervisor Leadership Institute through FBI-LEEDA, further strengthening supervisory leadership capabilities within the department.



## On the Call

### Significant Activity

On March 27, 2026, Officer Bronnenberg was patrolling the area of North State Route 48 and East Lower Springboro Road when he observed a vehicle traveling at a speed exceeding the posted 45 MPH limit. A traffic stop was conducted. Upon contact, officers detected the odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from the driver's breath. Following an investigation, the male driver was charged with Operating a Vehicle Impaired (OVI) and Speeding.

On March 27, 2026, Sergeant Sweet and Officer Hall were dispatched to the area of West State Route 122 and North State Route 741 regarding a report of a male walking in the roadway. The complainant advised that he stopped to check on the male, who then reached into the complainant's vehicle and attempted to grab his face. Officers later located the male at a residence in the 2400 block of West State Route 122. Following an investigation, the male was charged with Disorderly Conduct and Intoxication on a Highway.

On March 23, 2026, Sergeant Bates and Officer Robinson arrested a male subject at a residence in the 100 block of Grandview Drive on an active warrant out of North Carolina. The subject was taken into custody without incident.

On March 21, 2026, Officer Edwards was patrolling the area of Patricia Allen Park on North State Route 48 when he observed a vehicle entering the park and nearly strike a closed entrance gate. Officers initiated a traffic stop on North State Route 48 after observing multiple traffic violations. Upon contact, officers detected the odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from the driver's breath and observed a juvenile passenger in the vehicle. Following an investigation, the driver was charged with OVI, Driving Under Financial Responsibility Suspension, Expired Registration, and Endangering Children.

On March 14, 2026, Officer Horwarth was dispatched to B&B Carryout on East State Route 73 for a report of indecent behavior. The complainant reported that a male had urinated on the rear of a vehicle in the parking lot in view of the complainant's wife and juvenile child. Officers located the male, who was charged with Public Indecency and Underage Offenses.

On March 13, 2026, Officers Ledford and Robinson were dispatched to a residence in the 3500 block of North State Route 741 regarding a juvenile on probation who had removed his court-ordered ankle monitor. Officers located the juvenile, who was subsequently charged with Unruly Juvenile Offenses.

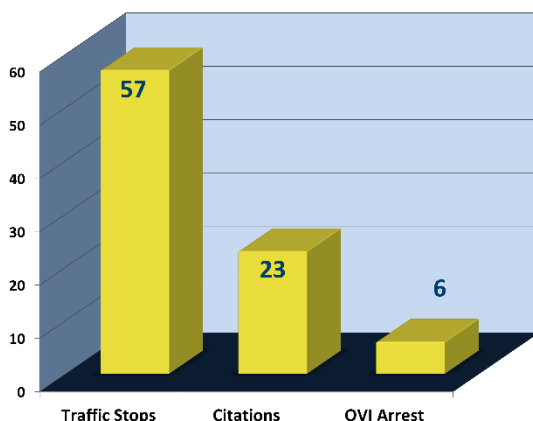
On March 10, 2026, Officer Bronnenberg was patrolling near North State Route 48 and Summerfield Lane when he observed a vehicle commit multiple marked lanes violations. A traffic stop was conducted. Officers detected the odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from the driver's breath. Following an investigation, the female driver was charged with OVI and Marked Lanes Violations.

On March 10, 2026, Officers Bronnenberg and Hall were patrolling the area of East State Route 73 and North State Route 48 when they observed a vehicle committing several traffic violations. A traffic stop was conducted, and officers detected the odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from the driver's breath. Following an investigation, the male driver was charged with OVI, Speeding, and Marked Lanes Violations.

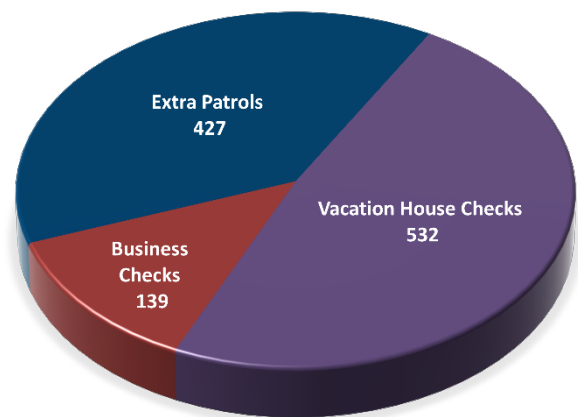
On March 9, 2026, Corporal Morgan and Officers Robinson and Ledford were dispatched to a residence on North State Route 741 for a report of a runaway juvenile. While searching the area, officers received an additional report of a suspicious juvenile in a nearby subdivision. Officers were assisted by the Clearcreek Township Police Drone Unit and the Warren County Sheriff's Office. The juvenile was located exiting a wooded area near Springboro Road. After a brief foot pursuit, the juvenile was taken into custody and charged with Obstructing Official Business.

On March 6, 2026, Officer Bronnenberg was patrolling near West Lytle Five Points and Yankee Road when he observed a motorcyclist commit a marked lanes violation. Additional violations were observed prior to the stop. Upon contact, officers detected the odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from the operator's breath. While retrieving identification, the operator opened a rear storage compartment, revealing a handgun. Following an investigation, the male operator was charged with OVI and Improper Handling of a Firearm in a Motor Vehicle.

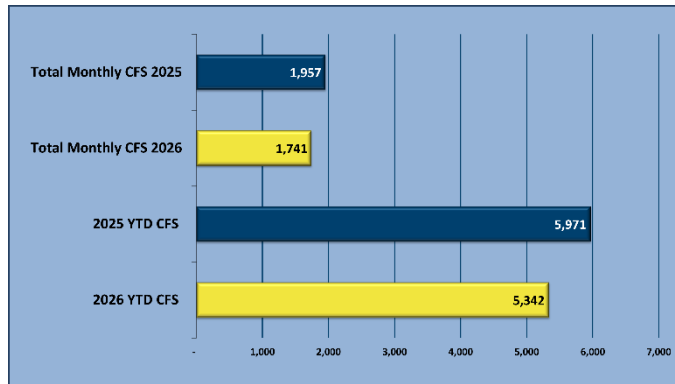

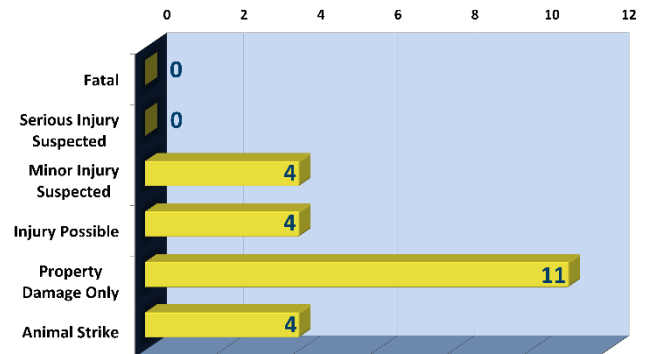
