



Clearcreek Road Department

Monthly Report

June 2026

During the first few days of June, crews completed final base repairs in subdivisions scheduled for paving. This included finishing work on Grand Cypress Boulevard in Cypress Ridge, where 10 tons of asphalt were used. In total, the Road Department completed 186 tons of base repair in advance of this year's paving program.

Crews prepared and leveled pads at Fire Stations 22 and 23 for the delivery of new 10' x 20' storage sheds.

Road Department staff also assisted the Parks Department by widening a driveway corner in preparation for paving.

During the third week of June, crews spent several days addressing a drainage issue on Highmount Drive. This location has historically experienced icing problems during the winter months, and the work was completed to improve drainage and reduce future hazards.

Following the heavy rainfall and excessive storm water earlier in the month, crews used the skid steer and power broom to clean the entrance to Crown Point Meadows, removing mud and debris left by the storm water.

The Road Department also began its subdivision tree-trimming program, clearing vegetation to improve sight distance at traffic signs and removing low-hanging branches that interfere with school buses, trash trucks, and snowplow trucks. This maintenance is typically performed on a three- to four-year rotation throughout the Township.

Between these projects, crews completed mastic patching on all roadways scheduled for this year's cape seal program. With the 2026 roads now complete, work has already begun on roads planned for the 2027 program.

The annual crack sealing program was also completed in June, with crews sealing 10 miles of roadway this year. Combined with last year's work, the Township has completed 26 miles of crack sealing over the past two years.

Lastly, the Township's annual paving program was completed in June, with a total of 5.7 miles of roadway resurfaced.



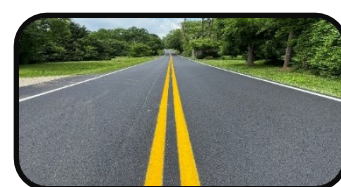
