CLEARCREEK TOWNSHIP WARREN COUNTY, OHIO

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE HARBORING OF BARKING DOGS AS A PUBLIC NUISANCE AND A MINOR MISDEMEANOR

WHEREAS, Section 955.221 (B) (2) Ohio Revised Code gives townships the authority to control dogs including the harboring of dogs and dogs as public nuisances, and;

WHEREAS, the Board of Clearcreek Township Trustees finds that dogs which howl, bark, or yelp creating unreasonably loud and disturbing noises of such a character, intensity or duration as to disturb the peace and quiet of the township are a public nuisance:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Clearcreek Township Trustees that:

SECTION 1. No person shall keep or harbor any dog within unincorporated Clearcreek Township which by barking, howling, or yelping creates unreasonably loud and disturbing noises of such a character, intensity or duration as to disturb the peace and quiet of any person in the township.

SECTION 2. All prosecutions for violations of **SECTION 1** of this resolution must be commenced by the filing of a minor misdemeanor citation by the Clearcreek Township Police Department.

SECTION 3. Any person who allows any dog to remain or be lodged or fed within any dwelling, building, yard or enclosure which said person owns or occupies, shall be considered to be harboring such dog.

SECTION 4. Whoever violates this resolution shall be fined not exceeding \$100.00 as set forth in Section 955.99 Ohio Revised Code.
