The Clearcreek Township Trustees met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. with the following members present: Mr. Gabbard, Mr. Muterspaw and Mr. Wade.

Mr. Wade opened the meeting, and led in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. Muterspaw moved to approve the regular meeting minutes of May 14, 2018. The motion was seconded by Mr. Gabbard and upon roll call the vote was as follows: Mr. Muterspaw-yea; Mr. Gabbard-yea; Mr. Wade-yea.

Mr. Gabbard moved to approve warrants #26764 through #27032 and electronic fund transfers #1057-2018 through #1164-2018. The motion was seconded by Mr. Muterspaw and upon roll call the vote was as follows: Mr. Gabbard-yea; Mr. Muterspaw-yea; Mr. Wade-yea.

Mr. Muterspaw moved to approve recommendation to offer Full Time, probationary employment position as Firefighter/EMT to Wade Easterling; effective June 1, 2018 at a probationary rate of pay of \$17.82/hour.
